Admission Policy

Admission to the Hifz School is based on:

› Student will be tested by the teachers prior to admission, in Tajweed/ Makharij (pronunciation of Arabic letters) and Nazra (Reading Quran). The student is expected to be fluent in reading Quran before admission in the Hifz Program. Student must pass this test before enrollment.

› There will be a probation period of three months in which the student's learning ability and aptitude will be judged by the teachers. After this trial period, the student may continue or he may be asked to leave the program depending upon the recommendation of his teacher. It is therefore recommended that the new students join in June of each academic year so that they can spend the probationary period during the summer vacation and in case they have to leave the program in three months, they do not miss out in their regular school. Also it would be up to the discretion of the parents when to buy the Calvert home schooling program. Our recommendation is to buy it when the Hifz teachers have passed the student after the probation period. This is to avoid the cost of the Calvert program, should the child leave the Hifz program after the probation period.

› Admission's criteria also include aptitude, unflinching life-long commitment to memorize and retain the Quran.
